Federal & Foundation Funding

Through the National Cancer Institute (NCI) Community Research Program, Illinois CancerCare shares in \$2.5 million of annual funding for NCI trials. This allows patients to participate in these clinical research efforts. However, due to cuts in NCI funding, we have seen a loss of \$3.5 million in research dollars in the past decade. Foundation dollars fill that gap — helping ensure local patients do not lose access to clinical trials. Illinois CancerCare is THE research arm for the many communities we serve — and YOU keep us armed to stay on top of ever-evolving care.



OUR INITIATIVES

Generous gifts to the Foundation make it possible to keep HOPE alive through funding of clinical research and the following initiatives:

EDUCATION & ADVOCACY: Community outreach plays an important role in bringing us closer to cures. Charitable gifts to the Foundation support educational events and training for volunteer advocates, equipping them with the tools they need to share the importance of clinical research with the goal of reducing barriers to trial participation.

GENETIC SCREENING: The Foundation supports genetic screening programs to identify hereditary cancers such as colorectal, pancreatic, and breast cancer. Thanks to generous contributors, eligible patients can receive financial assistance for their tumor sequencing. These programs empower families to understand their risks, provide relief, and make informed decisions about their health care.

PATIENT SUPPORT: Illinois CancerCare's volunteer program, with over 100 volunteers, provides a special touch to patients and families. Supported by gifts to the Foundation's Volunteer Fund, volunteers lend a helping hand and items of comfort for cancer patients during their visit. Foundation grants also provide transportation assistance and lymphedema support to qualified patients.

TRUST IN HOPE: The Foundation's Trust in Hope program provides compassion and support to cancer patients and their families experiencing financial need during the holidays. In the last 7 years alone, over 2,240 Thanksgiving meals have been delivered, and 151 families, and 375 children and their parents received holiday gifts.

FUNDRAISING: The Foundation supports over 12 events each year, with a total of 143 events since 2001. Some signature events include Swing for the Cure with the Peoria Chiefs, Golfin' in the Wild lead by the Young Leaders Board, and CUREageous lead by the CUREageous Committee. People can help by serving as a Foundation Ambassador, solicit new corporate partners, share about our programs and services, and support our events.
